To be considered, this application must be complete, signed and returned with all required attachments.

The Davis-Kozoll Scholarship was established in 2019 for students seeking a higher education for the following purposes: Applicant may pursue a master's, bachelor's or associate degree in a science and/or human service discipline without consideration of planned career location **OR alternatively**, applicant may pursue a degree or technical or vocational certificate or diploma for use in any planned trade or career in a northwest NM community.

Award will be made to students residing in northwest New Mexico with a priority for those students residing within the communities of Counselor, Cuba, Gallina, La Jara, Lindrith, Lybrook, Nageezi, Ojo Encino, Regina, San Luis and Torreon. **DEADLINE: Thursday, April 6, 2023 at 5:00pm MST. One to two awards of \$1,000 to \$5000 will be given annually.**

Criteria & Guidelines

- Applicant must be a resident of northwest New Mexico.
 - Preference will be given to students who reside in or near the following communities: Counselor, Cuba, Gallina, La Jara, Lindrith, Lybrook, Nageezi, Ojo Encino, Regina, San Luis or Torreon
- Applicant must be a senior in high school
- Applicant may pursue a master's, bachelor's or associate degree in a science and/or human service discipline without consideration of planned career location **OR**
- Alternatively, applicant may pursue a degree or technical or vocational certificate or diploma for use in any planned trade or career in a northwest New Mexico community
- Applicant may attend an accredited 4-year educational institution, 2-year community college, or technical or vocational program.
- Applicant must have a minimum 2.0 GPA
